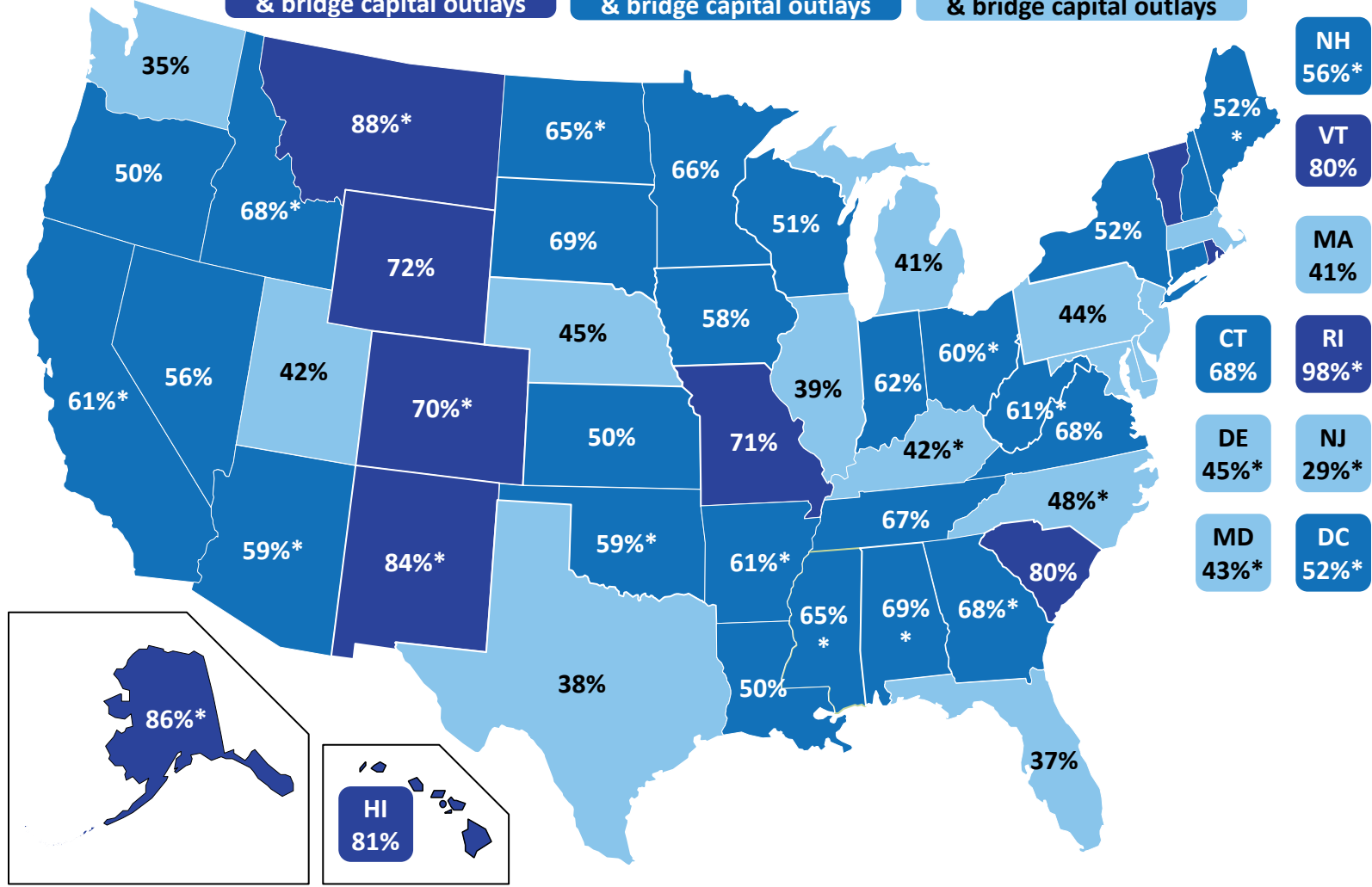


Federal funds, on average, provide 51% of annual State DOT capital outlays for highway & bridge projects

Over 69% of state highway & bridge capital outlays

50 to 69% of state highway & bridge capital outlays

29 to 49% of state highway & bridge capital outlays

Federal highway reimbursements are primarily used for capital outlays, including construction, right of way and engineering, but are also used for debt service for GARVEE bonds.
